## **VISITING STUDENTS & VETERINARY EXTERNS**

As part of your REC experience, you will be able to observe and participate in hospital and stable rounds, case workups and treatments, surgeries, yearling radiographs (if timing permits), and ambulatory veterinary services.

**ABOUT US:** The Randwick Equine Centre is a 20 veterinarian, purely equine practice. The practice services a wide range of horses, from miniature ponies to elite Thoroughbred race horses. Although we have extensive experience servicing the Thoroughbred racing industry, a wide range of breeds and conditions are treated on a daily basis.

Our hospital facilities include two surgery suites, two imaging suites (digital radiology, ultrasound, videoendoscopy and nuclear scintigraphy). The practice includes specialists in the fields of surgery, anaesthesia and medicine. The practice is supported by a fully equipped on-site laboratory.

**INTRODUCTION:** On your first day, you will be given a tour of the practice, and assigned a nurse or intern to oversee your stay. An overview of your activities and anticipated participation with the practice will be outlined. At this point we ask you clearly articulate to the nurse/intern or veterinarian present your level of experience with horses and horse handling capabilities. If you are asked to perform or assist in any task and you are not comfortable or understand what is required please let your supervisor know.

**INSURANCE:** If you are currently enrolled at University or TAFE, your course will need to provide proof of insurance. If you are not currently enrolled, you will need to provide your own insurance (personal injury), which must be presented prior to commencement.

**PAPERWORK:** If you have forms that need to be completed, it is up to you to present them to your supervisor during your stay to be filled in **at the time of your visit**.

**HOURS:** Monday – Friday 7.30am – 5:30pm / Saturday 7.30am – 10am As we are a 24 hour clinic there are plenty of after hours work and we encourage you to participate as you see fit.

**LUNCH:** Lunch is provided for employees only. Please bring some lunch or there is a 7 eleven nearby. If you place food in the fridge please label it clearly as your personal food. We would appreciate if you cleaned any cutlery or dishes you use.

**FOOTWEAR:** Leather protective footwear is required to be worn whilst working.
